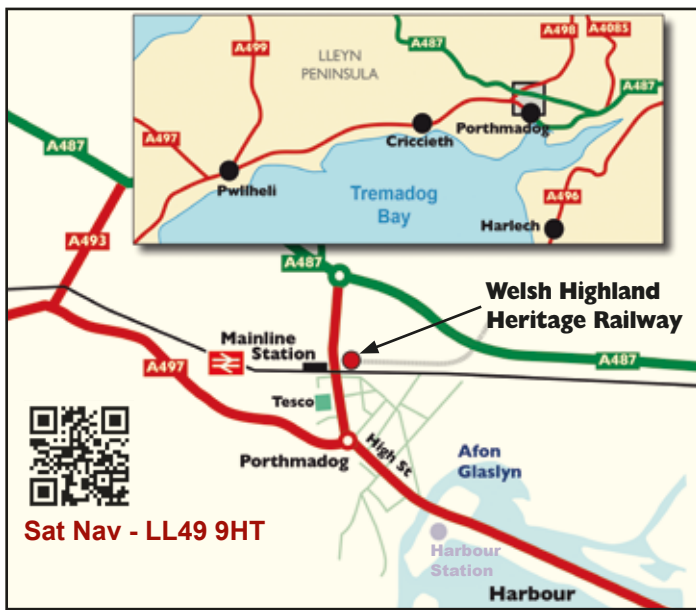

**By bicycle** - Route 8 on the National Cycle Network "Lon Las Cymru" passes our entrance. There are bike racks at our station.

Parking is FREE at our station though it can get busy. A long-stay pay-&-display park is just across the road.

Toilets with disabled access and baby changing facilities are located at Porthmadog Station and at the Heritage Centre.

A wheel-chair accessible coach runs on all our trains; it's also useful for push-chairs.

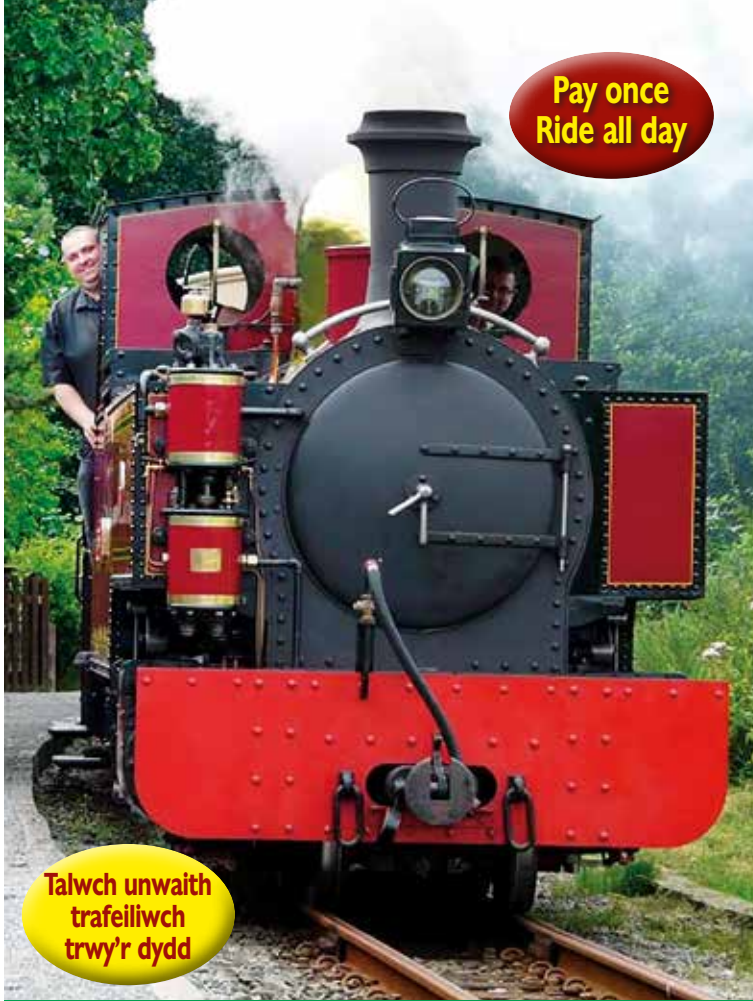
